Meeting called to order at 7:04pm by Chairman Sisk

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Committee Member Calhoun moved to approve the minutes from the October 15, 2013 meeting. Seconded by Committee Member Ullrich. All committee members present voted aye. Motion Carried.

OLD BUSINESS –

- **Ice Rink:** Committee Member O'Brien reported that he surveyed the park area and concluded that the retention area is not ideal for the rink. He explained that he marked a more level area by the pavilion with stakes as an alternative site. Committee Member O'Brien stated that he received quotes in the amount of \$581.40 from Home Depot for lumber and discussed a possible donation with the manager. He obtained a quote in the amount of \$382 from Nice Rink in Genoa City for the liner but the recommended liner for park use is priced at \$799.20. He stated that he would provide maintenance of the rink and water for the continued maintenance is available at Tiger's field. Because there is no lighting available at this time, Committee Member O'Brien stated that he may be able to construct a temporary solution for lights. Chairman Sisk stated that she would talk with a previous company she worked for to see if they are willing to donate lumber. Committee Member O'Brien suggested asking the community for donations. He stated that he could build the rink but would require assistance setting it up. The committee reached a consensus to finalize the cost and go before the board with a recommendation to move forward with an ice skating rink at Rescue Squad Memorial Park. If lighting is an issue, the committee discussed utilizing Sunnyside Park as an alternative.
- **No Tobacco in the Park Signs:** Chairperson Sisk discussed the upcoming contest to design the new "No Tobacco in the Parks" signs. The Committee discussed reaching out to St. Johns school as well as Johnsburg district 12 regarding the contest. Chairperson Sisk stated that

she will talk with the library about displaying the submissions and a possible voting location. Submissions will go through mid-January.

- **Meet and Greet Santa:** Committee Member McEvoy reported on the details for the Meet and Greet Santa event.

ADJOURNMENT

- Committee Member McEvoy moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Committee Member Dory. All committee members present voted aye. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:54 p.m.
