Field Use Agreement: Committee Member Calhoun asked for clarification regarding the user agreement. Chairperson Sisk addressed Member Calhoun's questions and reported that the Board approved the agreement.

Easter Egg Hunt: Committee Member McEvoy questioned advertisement and informed the committee they would be borrowing St. Johns' Easter Bunny outfit for the event. The committee will gather in the pavilion and take pictures to post on the website. Members agreed to meet an hour before the event to set up.

Farmers Market: Committee Member Ullrich reported on the farmers market. Chairperson Sisk informed the committee that there was a question regarding a farmers market on the Johnsburg Survey to get a feel for what the residents would like. Committee Member Ullrich will get a vendor list from Woodstock and will send a letter to the vendors with a questionnaire. The committee discussed the possibility of combining the Farmers Market with another event and agreed to discuss the location, dates and times for the Farmers Market at the next meeting. Discussion was had about starting the event at Sunnyside Park, possibly in July with the intention of moving it to Rescue Squad Memorial Park after the road construction is complete if it is determined that Rescue Squad Memorial Park is big enough for the event.

Movies in the Park: Committee Member O'Brien agreed to contact the library to see if they are interested in sharing the cost of renting the equipment. Chairperson Sisk reported that she sent an email to the company, Licensing Equipment but has not heard back yet. Discussion was had about initially renting the equipment however if the Village decides to host movies more

frequently, it will be more cost effective to purchase the equipment. Committee Member McEvoy agreed to call the City of McHenry to see what their process is. The Committee discussed hosting the first movie on June 20th.

Picture Submissions: Chairperson Sisk suggested the committee pursue the photo contest again this year. It will be further discussed at the next meeting.

Smoke Free Park Contest: Chairperson Sisk reported that she and President Hettermann presented the winners with a certificate, letter and prize and had pictures taken with them at the April 1st Board Meeting.

The committee discussed having the next meeting on May 13th.
