Meeting called to order at 7:02pm by Chairman Sisk

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Committee Member Ullrich moved to approve the minutes from the March 11, 2014 and the April 14, 2014 meetings. Seconded by Committee Member Ducak. All committee members present voted aye. Motion Carried.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT – Chairperson Sisk reported on the Village Board meeting regarding sale and purchase of police cars, Garrelts zoning request and ordinances that were approved.

NEW BUSINESS

Celebration in the Park: Chairman Sisk reported that Celebration in the Park will be October 4, 2014. She informed the committee that the Johnsburg Men's Club will not be in town that day so they will not be able to cook. She reported that Sunnyside Tavern has expressed interest in providing the food for the event. The committee discussed other details such as games, Wow Balls, bouncys and the band.

OLD BUSINESS

Movies in the Park: Committee Member Sisk informed the committee that the funds are not in the budget for Movie's in the Park and that whatever the committee decided would have to be based solely on donations. Committee Member O'Brien expressed his disappointment in the decision and Chairperson Sisk explained it was because of the rough winter and conditions of the roads. She presented the committee with a letter she would like to send to larger retail stores to ask for sponsorship and asked for the committee's thoughts. Committee Member Ullrich stated that some retailers such as Ray Chevrolet would donate as much as \$1,000 to have their banner displayed at Hiller Park for the full season. Committee Member Sisk expressed that she would prefer to have the sponsors listed in eblasts and banners on corners during the time of the event instead of having large displays at the park.

The Committee discussed the concession stand and the sale of packaged goods during the movie. Chairperson Sisk stated that the next meeting can be arranged to start ½ hour early so that the committee can meet at Hiller Park concession stand to take inventory. The next step is to send the letter to sponsors and follow up.

ADJOURNMENT

Committee Member Ullrich moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Committee Member O'Brien. All committee members present voted aye. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:07 p.m.
