APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Community Club is still interested and if they wants to sell alcohol at the event. She will then follow up with Village staff regarding the lighting of the tree.

NEW BUSINESS

After discussing the matter with Mr. Swartzloff & Mr. Wilcox it was agreed to have the Scout pursue a landscape project by the entry sign at Sunnyside Park.
