

**VILLAGE OF JOHNSBURG  
AUGUST 15, 2013 REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

President Hettermann called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Village Hall.

**FROM THE FLOOR** - President Hettermann acknowledged that there were several residents in attendance regarding the boat launch proposed by the Village of Lakemoor on Old Bay Road. He informed the residents that he spoke with the President of Lakemoor, Mr. Weihofen, who has agreed to pull the permit request off of the table at this time. President Hettermann stated that President Weihofen has been very cooperative and does not wish to cause concern to our residents. He added that he would be meeting with President Weihofen to discuss the matter further. President Hettermann agreed to keep the residents informed and asked that they sign in and provide their contact information.

Ed Sullivan of 1316 Old Bay Road stated that he feels a resolution objecting to the launch would be helpful in the event that Lakemoor fails to withdraw their petition as he believes the resolution from the Board would have more influence with the Army Corp of Engineers than citizen objections.

A resident in attendance expressed a desire to have the Village of Johnsburg obtain jurisdiction of that area of the road currently in the Village of Lakemoor. Discussion took place regarding the possibility of changing the jurisdictional boundaries of the road in the future. President Hettermann explained that there is a legal process that would have to be pursued in order to so.

Jason Schwan of 1214 Old Bay Road questioned why Lakemoor was harassing a neighborhood who had parked his trailer on Mr. Schwann's property. President Hettermann explained that residents of Old Bay Road attended a meeting hosted by President Weihofen regarding the proposed boat launch and at that meeting they expressed that the property has been neglected and people were improperly parking trailers in the area therefore President Weihofen directed his staff to clean up the property and pursue ordinance violations for the trailers.

The residents thanked the Village of Johnsburg for their representation at the meeting held by the Village of Lakemoor.

**OMNIBUS AGENDA** – Trustee Sisk moved to approve the Omnibus Agenda. Trustee McEvoy seconded the motion. All Trustees present voted aye on the roll. Motion carried.

- Move to approve the minutes of the July 11, 2013 Special Board Meeting and the July 18<sup>th</sup> Regular Board meeting.



Ordinance 13-14-16 Amending Chapter 12.07 regarding Noxious Plants, Weeds and Grass. President Hettermann explained that staff raised some concerns with the proposed amendments explaining that they may be too restrictive and enforcement would be challenging. He explained that decreasing the notice requirements to 5 days would not provide a reasonable amount of time for the violation to be addressed. Trustee Huemann pointed out that staff raised a concern that the Village itself could be in violation at times if the height restriction was reduced to six inches. Chief VonAllmen explained that the 8 inch grass limitation and 10 day notice is reasonable but he feels something should be done regarding notice requirements for repeat offenders. Rick Quinn suggested that language be included regarding the planting of vacant lots in new subdivisions with agricultural crops as is the current practice. The Board also discussed the implementation of a graduated fine structure which would increase after each offense.

Ordinance 13-14-17 Amending Chapter 14 Animal Control. Chief VonAllmen explained that ordinance provides for increased fines for dogs running at large. A first offense would be \$100 and a second offense would increase to \$200.

Ordinance 13-14-18 Amending Chapter 43.06 Weapons. Chief VonAllmen explained that the ordinance incorporates amendments in response to the new concealed carry laws and increases fines for offenses.

Ordinance 13-14-19 Amending Chapter 8 Parks and Playgrounds regarding Park Hours. The Board suggested that language be added to permit the use of the ramp earlier during duck hunting season. Trustee Huemann agreed to check into adequate starting hours to accommodate duck hunters.

**ADJOURNMENT** - Trustee Huemann moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee McEvoy seconded the motion. All Trustees present voted aye. Motion carried at 8:52 p.m.
