Pledge of Allegiance was said by all committee members present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve the minutes from the February 7, 2012 meeting was made by committee member Jill McEvoy and seconded by committee member Mike Koeshall.

NEW BUSINESS

A presentation by Mickey, on behalf of The Johnsburg Pigtail League was made regarding roofing for dugouts at Hiller Park Softball Fields. She explained that the league has been working with Village of Johnsburg building inspector Bill Swartzloff in the design and security of the roofs. She explained that the Pigtail League would ensure the dugout roofs match what the Village of Johnsburg plans to do at Show Case. Mickey also said that the Pigtail League will do fundraising for the project and supply the head volunteers to build the roofing. The CAC unanimously approved the project and will bring it to the Village of Johnsburg board.

CHAIRMAN REPORT

The report was included in the committee packet and a brief discussion took place on the electric aggregation to be put on the March 20th Ballet.

A brief discussion also took place regarding the Village of Johnsburg Newsletter being mailed to the presidents through consultants and that cost would be covered by local advertisements.

OLD BUSINESS

- **Update of Field Use:** Spoke about meeting with District 12 Operations Committee and that we are still waiting to go by the School Board. Also mentioned for the CAC to be prepared because the J-Hawk Football Team is splitting between Profit and Non-profit and not sure how this could affect community fields: (Village of Johnsburg and School District). Will try to keep going forward even with this new issue. Committee Member Jill McEvoy questioned how costing would be broken out for the proposed improvement and Chairman Sisk reported that the cost will be provided by whom will benefit from the improvement.
- **Hiller Park Dugouts:** Chairman Sisk handed out possibilities for dugout roofs along with storage boxes. She passed around the items Bill Swartzloff left for the Committee regarding

raising the dugout fencing and having the roofs secured to that the CAC overwhelmingly liked Bill Swartzloffs idea of raising the fencing and securing the roofs to that.

- **Running Brook Farms Park:** Chairman Sisk stated she made repeated attempts to contact John Sieck, The Running Brooks Farms Home Owners Association President. To no Avail. She stated she would continue to try to contact him but at this time there is no further discussion.

Chairman Sisk stated the next CAC meeting will be hold on April 10th at Village Hall
