Development Related Administration Fees – At the February 7, 2013 meeting a resident raised a concern regarding a recommendation made by the Ordinance Committee to eliminate the administration fee charged to developers. The fees were instituted to cover the cost impact the development review process has on the Village. The matter will be further discussed at a future meeting.

Broders Special Use Permit – At the February 7, 2013 meeting, the Village Board approved Ordinance 12-13-22 Granting a Special Use Permit for Warehouse, Mini-Storage as a Conditional Use and outside storage with screening for the property commonly known as 1370 Horizon Drive. The approval enables the property owner to expand his existing business.
