

Village Board Report – June 2014

Welcome to the Village Board Report which is placed on our website monthly to keep you informed of actions taken by the Village Board on ordinances and other significant matters.

FY 2015 Budget Review – At the June 3, 2014 meeting the Board discussed the proposed fiscal year 2015 Budget and reviewed year end totals for fiscal year 2014. At the June 17, 2014 meeting a full budget presentation was performed after which the budget was unanimously approved. Remington Grove Subdivision – At the June 3, 2014 meeting, the Village Board heard a request to approve a Second Amendment to the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, Easements and Restrictions and a Cross Easement and Cost Sharing Agreement for Remington Grove Subdivision, both of which were approved by the Board at the June 17, 2014 meeting.

Mutual Aid Agreement – At the June 3, 2014 meeting the Village Board approved an Intergovernmental Mutual Aid Agreement with the Village of Wonder Lake.

Mosquito Abatement Agreement – At the June 3, 2014 meeting the Village Board approved an Intergovernmental Agreement with McHenry Township for mosquito abatement services.

Johnsburg Explorers Donation – At the June 17, 2014 meeting, the Village Board approved the transfer of donated funds from the McHenry Area Youth Commission to the Johnsburg Explorer’s program

Impact Fees – At the June 17, 2014 meeting, the Village Board approved the release of the following development impact fees: Johnsburg School District - \$60,063.96; Johnsburg Library District - \$2,775.63; and McHenry Township Fire Protection District - \$5,326.14.

Ordinances – the Village Board approved the following ordinance at the June 17, 2014 meeting:

- Ordinance 14-15-04 Amending Certain Sections of Chapter 15, Traffic of the Johnsburg Municipal Code.
