

Village Board Report – March 2016

Welcome to the Village Board Report which is placed on our website monthly to keep you informed of actions taken by the Village Board on ordinances and other significant matters.

Downtown Planning Status – At the March 8, 2016 meeting, Village Engineer Tim Hartnett reviewed the status of the downtown planning efforts being pursued by the Economic Development Committee. He explained that this final phase of the planning incorporates all of the work completed in the first three phases and begins to identify some potential land uses in the downtown area. Mr. Hartnett emphasized the plan does not rezone property, but provides guidance for future development of the parcels in the area.

VILLAGE PROPERTY MAINTENANCE – At the March 8, 2016 meeting the board accepted the proposal from Hiller’s Property Management LLC for mowing of Village Properties for the 2016 season.

FY 2016 AUDITING SERVICES - At the March 29, 2016 meeting the board accepted the proposal from Lauterbach and Amen in the amount of \$10,500 for FY 2016 auditing services.

MFT ROAD PROGRAM – At the March 29, 2016 meeting the board accepted the proposal from Geske and Sons, Inc. in the amount of \$158,006.90 for the 2016 MFT Road Program.

ZONING MAP – At the March 29, 2016 meeting the board approved the 2016 Zoning Map.
