

## **Village Board Report – November 2015**

*Welcome to the Village Board Report which is placed on our website monthly to keep you informed of actions taken by the Village Board on ordinances and other significant matters.*

**Intergovernmental Agreement** – At the November 3, 2015 meeting the Board approved an Intergovernmental Agreement Between the County of McHenry, the City of Crystal Lake, the City of Harvard, The City of Marengo, the City of McHenry, the City of Woodstock, The Village of Huntley, the Village of Johnsburg, the Village of Ringwood and the Village of Lakewood for General Public Dial-A-Ridge Transit Services for 2016.

**Engineering Contract** – At the November 3, 2015 meeting the Board accepted a proposal from HR Green in the amount of \$89,985.59 for Phase II Engineering and a proposal from Midland Standard Testing in the amount of \$9,507 for soil exploration related to the Church Street Road Improvement Project.

**Letter of Credit Reduction/Running Brook Farms Subdivision** – At the November 3, 2015 meeting, the Board approved a reduction of \$53,758 in the letters of credit for Running Brook Farms Single Family Home development posted by KLM Builders contingent upon Village Engineer, Village Attorney and Village Administrator final review and approval.

**Farm Lease** – At the November 3, 2015 meeting the Board accepted bids for the lease of farm land generally located on the west side of South Solon Road, north of the intersection of South Solon Road and Ringwood Road and accepted the bid from Chuck Schaefer to lease the property.

**Proclamation** – At the November 17, 2015 meeting the Board approved a Proclamation in support of #McHenry County Gives, encouraging people to support through time, talent or treasure a non-profit organization of their preference.

**Ordinances** - At the November 3rd and November 17th meetings, the Board approved the following ordinances.

- Ordinance 15-16-13 Adopting the McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance.
- Ordinance 15-16-14, An Ordinance Calling for a Referendum to Implement Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation, Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation and non-Home Rule Municipal Use Taxes in the Village of Johnsburg, McHenry County, Illinois, at the General Primary Election to be Held on March 15, 2016
