

Village Board Report – October 2015

Welcome to the Village Board Report which is placed on our website monthly to keep you informed of actions taken by the Village Board on ordinances and other significant matters.

Employment – At the October 6, 2015 meeting, the Board authorized the hiring of an additional full time public works employee at a rate of \$12.00 per hour.

MFT Road Program - At the October 6, 2015 meeting, the Board authorized payment in the amount of \$345,532.73 to Payne and Dolan for the 2015 Road Resurfacing Program

Church Street Road Improvement Project – At the October 6, 2015 meeting, the Village Engineer provided an update to the Board on the status of Phase I Engineering for the Church Street Project.

Johnsburg Rescue Squad – At the October 6, 2015 meeting, President Hettermann informed the Board that the Johnsburg Rescue Squad has officially dissolved and has donated the rescue squad to the Village to be used for parades and other approved functions. He turned over a check in the amount of \$22,700 from the Johnsburg Rescue Squad to be used for lighting in Rescue Squad Memorial Park.

Emergency Warning Sirens – At the October 20, 2015 meeting, members of the McHenry Township Fire Protection District addressed the board regarding a new emergency warning siren just installed at Station 2 in Johnsburg. They also discussed plans for future sirens in the area to provide better coverage to the community. The Board then authorized payment for the cost of half of the siren in the amount of \$7,433.50.

Administration Software - At the October 20, 2015 meeting, the Board accepted the proposal from B S & A in an amount not to exceed \$80,680 for the purchase of software for the Administration Department to include training and data conversion.

Police Dispatch Agreement – At the October 20, 2015 meeting the Village Board approved an Intergovernmental Agreement for Police Dispatch Services between the City of McHenry and the Village of Johnsburg.

Ordinances - At the October 20, 2015 meeting, the Board approved the following ordinances.

- Ordinance 15-16-11 Authorizing the Sale of Surplus Property No Longer in Use by the Village.
- Ordinance 15-16-12 Amending Chapter 4 of the Johnsburg Municipal Code adding 4.03F Community Service Officer.
