

Village Board Report – September 2014

Welcome to the Village Board Report which is placed on our website monthly to keep you informed of actions taken by the Village Board on ordinances and other significant matters.

Public Hearings for Back up Special Service Area – Remington Grove Subdivision – At the September 2, 2014 meeting, the Village Board held hearings regarding the proposed establishment of backup Special Service Areas (SSAs) for Remington Grove Subdivision. The proposed SSAs would serve as a backup means of funding the cost of maintenance of common areas should the homeowners associations fail to do so.

Marketing – At the September 2, 2014 meeting, the Village Board approved the expenditure of up to \$1,000 for aerial videography and photography of the Roundabout Ribbon Cutting Ceremony and Saufen und Spiel events. The footage will be incorporated into marketing materials the Village is developing.

Committee Appointments – At the September 16, 2014 meeting, the Village Board consented to two new committee member appointments.

Johnsburg State Bank Litigation - At the September 16, 2014 meeting, the Village Board was advised that attempted negotiations have not resulted in an alternative resolution regarding the outstanding public improvements in Whispering Ridge Subdivision for which the State Bank must complete therefore litigation continues in the matter.
