Old Business	<p>Committee was provided stats from JBPD, Staff reported tracker provided from statistical data of the three (3) amended Municipal Chapters; Burning, NonHighway and Boat Launch.</p> <p>Committee reviewed and discussed the changes to recommend amendments to Municipal Code Ch. 8 - Use of Boat Launch – Contractor/Commercial activity. Discussion from members reviewed increased fees to be daily specific and identifying days and time limitations, providing the intended use of recreational activity being priority. The committee members agreed that violations should be greater than a recreational boat launch and that the activity should be limited to corporate jurisdiction only, Johnsburg proper residents use only.</p>	<p>Motion from Committee Member Markunas moved to reword changes from discussion to Municipal Code Ch. 8 ensuring Village jurisdiction specific on certain days and allotted times and have it courtesy reviewed from Village Counsel. Committee Member Diedrich seconded the motion. All Committee Members present voted aye. Motion carried to present updated language to review and Village counsel findings at next ORD meeting.</p>
