#### SHERYL SUDAR FENCE VARIANCE REQUEST

Sheryl Sudar attended to request that the Planning and Zoning Commission for the Village of Johnsburg recommend that a variance be granted to Section 7.2-1 Permitted Fences, to permit the placement of a chain link fence in the front yard of her property at 1912 River Terrace Drive, PIN# 10-18-303-002.

Ms. Sudar explained wants the fence because her property is located three houses from a liquor establishment. Additionally, she has a small dog and grandkids and she wants to insure their safety when they are out playing in the yard.

#### **QUESTIONS FROM THE COMMISSION**

Commission Member Niggemann questioned if there is a fence already constructed on either side of her. Sudar replied that there are no fences directly next to her but there are other properties with fences in the neighborhood. Ms. Sudar pointed out the fence placement on her plat of survey. Commission Member Wiltse questioned the height of the fence. Sheryl Sudar replied that it will be four feet in height. Commission Member Wiltse also questioned if the petitioner received any feedback from the neighbors. Ms. Sudar replied that everyone she spoke with is fine with the fence. Commission Member Niggemann questioned if she considered a wooden fence rather than the chain link fence. Ms. Sudar stated that she looked at other fence types but thought the chain link was the best choice for them.
