Approval of Minute	Committee Member Rudzena moved to approve April 23, 2024 public works committee minutes as written. Committee Member Steffens seconded the motion. All Committee Members present voted aye. Motion carried.
Old Business	Chairman Letzter discussed with committee SSA 33 – Sunnyside Beach Dr recent update and findings related to IR repairs to manholes, drainage stabilization from ROW and gate finalization. Church St Road Realignment final punch list items being finished out of walkthrough repairs needed to scope. Sewer Updates related to Eastside Sanitary Sewer Expansion that has been delayed from actual start, but still proceeding forward in 2024. Riverside Drive Road Improvement (2024) currently closed and work being completed with box culvert install and stabilization surround pending further on road milling and resurfacing.
New Business	Committee Member Schaefer requested clarification for address Sweetwater Rd off SG Rd under the developer – RJ Land Corps (Pease) responsibility has Chairman Letzter advised not a road accepted from Village, but agreements are currently being discussed at Village level with Letters of Credit and improvements needed before acceptance. Committee discussed some safety concerns observed and noted comments for Public Works employee to be implemented immediate adjacent to roadway and operations. Further discussion developed regarding the state/condition of Berkshire Johnsburg development and the prairie grass areas. Question were discussed regarding MTFPD St#2 and recent permitting improvements at which time was discussed permitted with Village and meets guideline scopes in concrete as proposed.
