Village Board Report – October 2013 *Welcome to the Village Board Report which is placed on our website monthly to keep you informed of actions taken by the Village Board on ordinances and other significant matters.*

<u>Sidewalk Improvement Project</u> – At the October 3, 2013 meeting, the Village Board awarded a contract to Upland Construction and Maintenance LLC to construct a sidewalk on Fairview Avenue between Church Street and Johnsburg Road and along Channel Beach Avenue between Johnsburg Road and the Sunnyside Memorial Park. The Johnsburg Library District is partnering with the Village on this project and will be extending a sidewalk from the new Fairview Avenue sidewalk into their property. This is an important project for the community as it will provide a means for children to travel between the schools and the library and to Sunnyside Memorial Park in a designated area out of the roadway.

<u>Conditional Offer of Employment</u> – At the October 17, 2013 meeting the Village Board approved a conditional offer of employment for the hiring of a new police officer.

<u>Vehicle Purchase</u> – At the October 17, 2013 meeting the Village Board approved the purchase of a 2014 Dodge Charger.

<u>Ordinances</u>

At the October 3, 2013 meeting, the Board approved Ordinance 13-14-20 authorizing the sale of two vehicles no longer used by the Police Department. Notice of the sale will be published in the local paper.

At the October 17, 2013 meeting the Board approved Ordinance 13-14-21 authorizing the Village to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of McHenry for communication system enhancements. The agreement provides for the installation of communication infrastructure on the Village's water tower.

At the October 17, 2013 meeting the Board approved Ordinance 13-14-22 granting variances to Sections 7.1-2, 7.1-5 and 7.1-7 regarding Accessory Buildings and Structures to accommodate the construction of a detached garage for the property commonly known as 1817 Sunnyside Beach Drive.
